Along with technical progress and gains of speed, "one learns to make twice as many pins in a given time rather than to make a quantity of pins in half the time"(Russell,1932). In line with this quote, the impact of efficiency improvement on time uses dedicated to various activities follows the same emphasis. Faster transportation: make twice as many kilometres in a given time rather than to travel a given number of kilometers in half the time. Faster communication: make twice (and even more) as many e-mails in a given time rather than to send a quantity of email in half the time....

Even though those examples describe the same logic, time rebound effects applied to transport – also known as the “Zahavi conjecture” - are part of a reflection that is rather compartmentalised in the field of transport. In a perspective of ecological transition, to better understand the relative problems of consumption of time, space and energy, the seminar aims to create interdisciplinary bridges on time rebound effects.
